ATD doubled the amount raised to commit \$1 million to GSF.

"We're thrilled by the support this campaign received from

"Supporting the Gary Sinise Foundation represents our growth as a company, our own emphasis on mental wellness and our patriotism and commitment to our service members, veterans and first responders," Schuette added. The Summer for Heroes Giving Campaign ran from Memorial Day through Patriot Day, and the fundraising campaign marked the first time ATD partnered with its manufacturing and retail customers to reach the shared goal of supporting the nation's heroes. With the support of partners in the tire industry, ATD doubled its fundraising goal of \$500,00 to present \$1 million to the Gary Sinise Foundation.

"Our nation's heroes have sacrificed so much defending our country and deserve to have the best possible tools at their disposal to address their mental wellness needs. But, unfortunately, too many of these heroes are losing the battle to post-traumatic stress, traumatic brain injury, and substance abuse every day. It is up to us, as citizens, to support them, and that is exactly our mission with the Gary Sinise Foundation Avalon Network," said Mike Thirtle, CEO of the Gary Sinise Foundation.

The donation was announced during ATD's 31st Annual Charity Golf Classic and Inaugural Gala for Heroes, hosted on November 12 in Charlotte, North Carolina.
